### Wellness & Physical Education

Each first grade class will receive a class on dental health. Through the use of an age appropriate video and health curriculum materials, children will learn about good dental hygiene. The lesson will also describe the importance of healthy eating and of getting regular dental check-ups.

Each Kinder class will receive training on hand-washing hygiene procedures to insure that children learn the proper method of handwashing.

Coaches will provide up to 225 minutes weekly of structured moderate to vigorous physical activity level for 50% of the class period.

Fitness Gram assessment will be conducted with all students in Physical Education grades 3-5, TEA Code 38.101/38.103. Assessments will be conducted to obtain Pre & Post information which is available to parents upon request.



### Community & Parental Involvement

Campus will conduct 5 or more parent sessions with emphasis on all content areas and provide strategies to prepare students for the state assessment.

Campus will provide 5 or more parent meetings relevant to district programs and services.

Campus will provide parents with 5 or more opportunities to participate in campus decision making committees to provide input concerning preparation methods for mastering state assessments.

Campus will provide 5 or more tutoring programs that support students who will be taking state assessments.

Campus will offer 5 or more campus based community service projects per year.

Campus will have over 50 parent and community volunteers.

Campus will have an increase of 15% in the total number of volunteer hours recorded.



### 21st Century Workforce Development Program

School will offer career days or information to the majority of students.

Speakers will periodically visit classrooms to provide career information to the majority of the students.
