A B Cs Of Student Success

N is for NOTHING.

Was "Nothing" your child's response to the question "What did you do at school today?"
- Instead of asking about the day as a whole, ask about math or lunchtime or recess or...
- Don't ask yes or no questions. Ask *What did you think...?* or *How did you decide...?*
- At dinnertime, ask each member of the family to tell the best and worst thing that happened that day. That opens the door to conversation, sharing experiences and tips for handling frustration, and emphasizing that something good happens every day.

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Parent Pointers Teaching Responsibility

- ▶ Teach your child responsibility. Every child should have home chores that they are expected to complete. Allowances might be tied to completing those chores.
- ▶ When appropriate, motivate your child with rewards and consequences.
- ▶ Be understanding with your child when he or she makes a mistake. We all learn from our mistakes.
- ▶ Learning to make wise decisions comes from practice and encouragement.

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Parent Pointers Communicating With Older Children

- ▶ Stay involved with your child.
- ▶ Know what is going on at school and with friends in your child's life.
- ▶ Spend more time listening to what they have to say. Don't interrupt them when they are talking. Then they'll spend more time listening to you.
- ▶ When communicating with your older child, be brief. Avoid the use of words such as *guilt*, *never*, *always*...
